For the newcomers your programs *cannot* take on — not for lack of ability, but of eligibility.

Prépara is a private English-coaching program, guided in French, built for francophone newcomers who fall outside LINC eligibility: work permit holders, study permit holders, and spouses awaiting status. **It is a resource you can hand someone when there is nowhere else to send them.**

Who this is for

- **Work permit holders** who need workplace English but do not qualify for free settlement language training.
- **Study permit holders**, including international students who are not yet at the English level required to register for a program.
- **Spouses and family members** waiting on permanent residence status.
- **Anyone assessed as ineligible for LINC** who asks what else exists.

What it is

Prépara is a private language-training platform, not an accredited school. It does not issue an official diploma or credential.

Prépara is not a replacement for LINC or any funded settlement program, and we do not position it as one. It exists for the people those programs cannot currently serve. If someone qualifies for free language training, that should always come first.

Why this exists

Co-founded by someone who has worked directly in international student admissions and has seen how often a candidate's file stalls on English level alone, before ability, funding, or intent ever come into question.
